Straw Blow Snow Globe

Make your own snow storm with this whimsical straw-blown snow globe. It's a fun and creative project, and doesn't use water, so there is no risk of spillage.



To Make A Snow Globe, You Will Need

A clear plastic cup
2 Small sheets of paper
Cardboard
Sticky tape
Scissors
A Straw
A pen or pencil
Colour pens/crayons

Hole punch (optional)

How to make your snow globe.

- 1) Place your cup upside down onto the cardboard and draw around the opening.
- 2) Cut out the circle of cardboard you have just drawn and put the circle to one side. You will use this later.
- 3) Draw an Arctic scene on one of the piece of paper and tape it to the inside of the cup.
- 4) Use the other piece of paper to cut lots of tiny bits of paper, or use the hole punch to create lots of paper dots.
- 5) Put all the tiny bits of paper into the cup.
- 6) Place the circle bit of cardboard on the opening of the cup and use tape to stick it all around the edge. Leave a tiny gap at the front just big enough to put your straw in.
- 7) Turn the cup upside down and insert your straw in the gap. Blow through the straw to create your snow storm.
